## Seizure of SNC Bank Account at the Royal Bank of Canada in August 1991.

You will recall previous correspondence between us about this, and my claim on SNC for \$1.5 million as at August 1991. I will be leaving Canada near the end of May and you would do well to settle with me beforehand. The original claim of \$1.5 million as at August 1991 is now increased to account for accrued interest since August 1991, calculated at 7.2% simple interest per annum, as follows:

Original claim

\$1.5 million

plus: 21 months simple interest at  $7.2^{\circ}$ / per annum, or 0.6% per \$189,000 to May 31st, 1993

Total

\$1,689,000

You will arrange transfer of this amount to my account at the Royal Bank of Canada, Sherbrooke and Viau Branch, account number 7152648, by 1200 hours on Monday, May 10th, failing which you and SNC will face certain exposure for the reasons previously detailed involving your personal conduct, SNC's conduct and the conduct of Dunton, Rainville, Toupin and Perrault.

This may seem short notice but you have been warned often enough before. Quebec is not supposed to be a haven for corrupt businessmen and incompetent lawyers. A man of your education, part of which was in England, should know better than to permit what went on as a means of "justifying" employment for weak, stupid, cowardly, corrupt and incompetent lawyers - when everybody knows that Canada has far too many lawyers per head of population already (compared with, say, Japan) and this sort of thing is obviously partly why Canada has become so un-competitive internationally.

You are also reminded that if anything untoward happens to me, other people have instructions to reveal everything to the media and law-enforcement authorities, so don't start any nonsense.

I also note from the 1991 Annual Report , published in March 1992, how concerned you and Jean-Paul Gourdeau are to project an image of SNC as a good corporate citizen that

should do its bit to alleviate poverty. This, as far as am concerned, is a pack of lies and you know it.
