Dear Mrs. Gaffney:

I enclose for your information, a copy of the letter that I received from the Governor General's Office, in reply to my complaints about Guy Saint-Pierre, President of SNC.

It is quite obvious that the whole thing is done behind closed doors, with no opportunity for comment by the public. Under the circumstances therefore, I have to say that the process by which Order of Canada appointments are made, is flawed.

I also understand that there will not be a letter from the Chief Justice after all, and I would have thought that it is something that he <u>should</u> take a <u>very</u> serious interest in. Inspection of his "Who's Who" biography will reveal why – this is enclosed. However, it is likely that he personally was never even told about it - nobody <u>wants</u> to understand the implications. I wrote to the Bar Association of Quebec on October 30th, enclosing the same documents that I sent to you – so that now I would hope Judge Lamer will <u>have</u> to take an interest in it, in his capacity as a member of the <u>Disciplinary Board of the Quebec Bar Association</u>; I enclose a copy of my letter to the Quebec Bar Association for your information.

I also enclose some other things that I believe you will find to be of interest:-

(a) Guy Saint-Pierre's "Who's Who" biography, from which you will see that he is a Director of the Royal Bank of Canada, where SNC have their account which was seized by my lawyers in 1991.

(b) My letter of today's date to Mr. John E. Cleghorn, President and Chief Operating Officer of the Royal Bank of Canada. The documents that I sent to him are identical to the ones that I sent to you, except that I have added a paragraph concerning Guy Saint-Pierre's position as a Director of the Royal Bank and also his position as a Governor of the Conseil du Patronat du Quebec, and the implications for the Royal Bank and Guy Saint-Pierre if there is a scandal.

If you have any suggestions concerning what should be done, other than what I am doing already, I would be interested to hear them.
